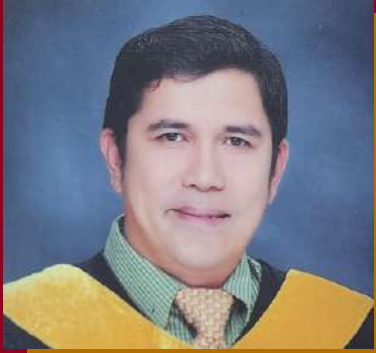

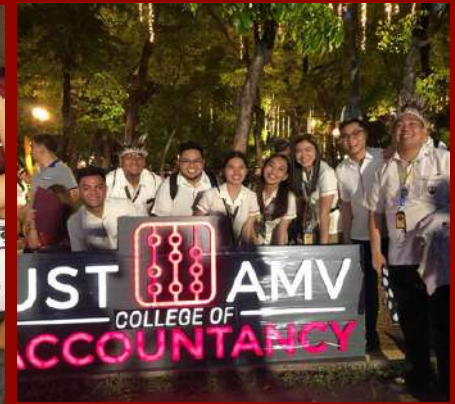

UPDATES FROM COLLEGE

Since its founding in 2004, UST-Alfredo M. Velayo College of Accountancy (UST-AMV CoA) has built its reputation on strong academics and professional skills through the program Bachelor of Science in Accountancy (BSA). This program lays the groundwork for shaping students into capable, ethical, and well-rounded Certified Public Accountants (CPAs). The rigorous curriculum covers essential topics like financial accounting and reporting, auditing, taxation, and regulatory frameworks, all of which align with the knowledge and skills assessed in the Philippine CPA Licensure Examination. Students receive training in technical skills, critical thinking, professional judgment, and social responsibility. BSA graduates often find work in public practice, corporate finance, government, and academia, with many moving into leadership roles in both local and international firms. The program's long-standing success has made it a key part of the country's accounting profession, consistently producing top performers and industry leaders.



To meet changing demands in the business world, the college started offering the Bachelor of Science in Management Accounting (BSMA) program in 2007. This program is meant for students seeking a strategy-focused and business-oriented view of accounting. It highlights managerial decision-making, financial planning, cost control, and performance evaluation. Its curriculum connects accounting principles with analytical and operational skills, preparing students for certifications like the Certified Management Accountant (CMA). BSMA graduates are particularly valued in corporate environments where financial insights shape strategic decisions. Common career paths include controllership, financial analysis, and management consulting roles. The program also suits those interested in further business strategy and operations studies.

UPDATES FROM COLLEGE



Recognizing the increasing role of technology in finance, UST-AMV CoA introduced the Bachelor of Science in Accounting Information System (BSAIS) in 2021. This modern program addresses the digital shift in accounting by blending basic accounting knowledge with technology and analytical tools. The curriculum covers special training in database management, systems design, cybersecurity, enterprise resource planning (ERP), and IT auditing. It prepares students for certifications like the Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA) and develops skills for systems analyst, IT auditor, and enterprise systems consultant careers. The BSAIS program is perfect for students who aim for careers at the crossroads of accounting, technology, and risk management, where ensuring digital safety is as essential as financial accuracy.

A significant recent change for UST-Alfredo M. Velayo College of Accountancy was its move to a new campus. After 15 years at the UST multi-deck carpark, the college officially relocated to the Albertus Magnus Building on December 1, 2021. This decision was influenced by safety concerns about the car park's structural integrity. The college officials noted that the building was not initially designed for student use, and its layout posed risks for the large student body. Plans to move began as early as 2019 but were postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Albertus Magnus Building, which is 52 years old, is now the new home for UST-AMV CoA. It is shared with other academic units, including the College of Education, the Conservatory of Music, and the Education High School. The relocation has offered students and faculty a safer and better learning environment, reinforcing the university's commitment to student welfare and academic achievement.



UPDATES FROM COLLEGE

The students of the University of Santo Tomas–Alfredo M. Velayo College of Accountancy (UST-AMV CoA) continue to show academic excellence, resilience, and leadership. As of Academic Year 2024–2025, the college reported 1,922 enrolled students, indicating a vibrant and competitive academic atmosphere, even with a slight decline from the previous year’s 2,204 students. This number includes a strong group of freshmen, showing ongoing interest in the College’s specialized programs in Accountancy, Management Accounting, and Accounting Information Systems.

Academically, the UST-AMV CoA students are active in local and international competitions, research projects, and professional development. The College’s focus on ethics, analytical depth, and global readiness is clear in its alumni’s consistent results in licensure examinations and their pursuit of certifications such as CPA, CMA, and CISA. Student organizations like the UST Accountancy Student Council and academic societies, including the UST–Junior Philippine Institute of Accountants, the UST Society of Business Managerial Accountants, and the UST Accounting Information System Society, host programs that include review sessions, leadership seminars, and case competitions, encouraging a culture of excellence and teamwork.



Additionally, the college’s recent partnerships, including the 2025 Memoranda of Agreement with SGV & Co. and the SGV Foundation, Inc., have opened up new opportunities for academic support, mentorship, and exposure to the industry. These collaborations enhance the learning experience and prepare students for the changing needs in the accounting profession.

As the UST–Alfredo M. Velayo College of Accountancy evolves, it remains deeply rooted in its mission to form competent, compassionate, and committed Thomasian accountants. 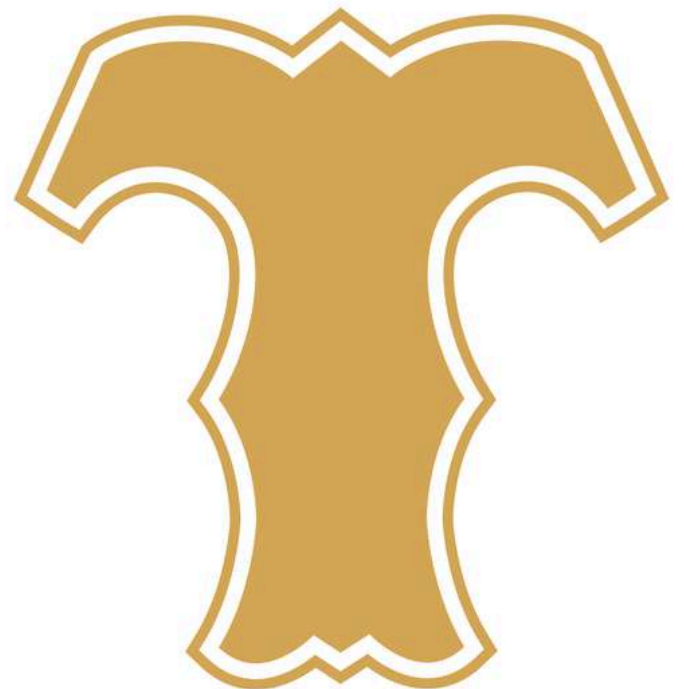

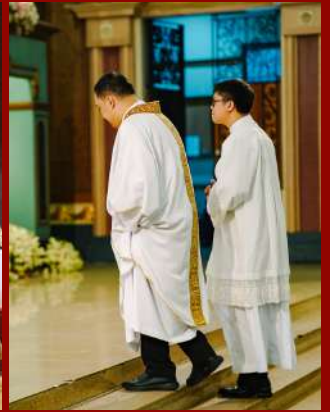

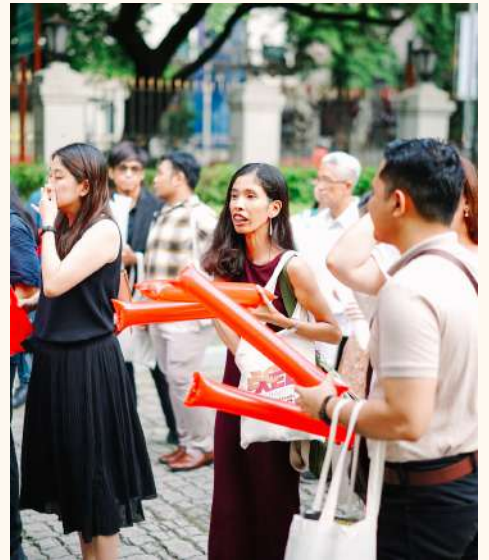
